Voting members: Area Officers, Area Coordinators, District Representatives, and all Past Delegates.

Voice: Any Al-Anon member may attend and speak at AWSC meeting.

- Role:
1. Steering committee for Area Assembly.
 2. Proposes actions to Assembly .
 3. Creates agenda for subsequent Assembly.
 4. AWSC meets approximately 6 weeks before the Area Assembly..

Area Assembly

Voting members: Group Representatives (GR) from each group in the Area.

Non-voting members:

1. Area Chair, Area Delegate, Area Alternate Delegate/Chair.
2. Area Treasurer if they are not also a GR.
3. Area Secretary if they are not also a GR..
4. District Representatives if they are not also a GR.
5. Area Coordinators if they are not also a GR..

Voice: Any Al-Anon member may attend, speak, and bring proposals to Assembly meetings.

- Role:
1. Serves as group conscience for the Area.
 2. Elects the Area Delegate as our participant in the worldwide group conscience that is the World Service Conference (WSC).
 3. Elects Area Officers.
 4. Discusses and votes on actions proposed by the AWSC and other actions brought up by members.
 5. Meets 3 times a year in March, July, and November.
